A Search Engine for your PalmPilot®

Features:

Palm OS 5 support.

ToDo "plug-in".

MemoPad "plug-in".

Date Book "plug-in".

Address Book "plug-in".

Provides the ability to ask your PalmPilot questions in English and locates information related to the question you ask, not just the words in your question.

Lets you optionally search for ANY number of words or phrases simultaneously.

Breaks the 16 character limit imposed on searches by the PalmPilot's built-in Find function.

Lets you optionally find "hits" that contain ALL words or phrases entered.

Lets you optionally search for words or phrases in a case sensitive OR insensitive manner.

Lets you search for phrases that contain tabs and/or spaces such as "Leonardo da Vinci".

Lets you search using the dot (.) "wild card" allowing you to search for any generic character. Thus searching for '.an' will find 'Dan' and 'man'.

Lets you search using the question mark (?) "wild card" allowing you to search for none or one of the previous characters. Thus searching for 'd?an' will find 'dan' and 'man'.

Lets you search using the plus (+) "wild card" allowing you to search for one or more of the previous characters. Thus searching for 'd+an' will find 'dan' and 'ddan' but not 'man'.

Lets you search using the star (*) "wild card" allowing you to search for zero or more of the previous characters. Thus searching for 'z*ing' will find 'building' and 'sing'.

Lets you escape the meaning of the "wild cards" allowing you to search for a literal '!', '?', '"', or '+'. Thus searching for '.ello\?' will find 'hello?' but not 'mellow'.

Lets you easily enter "wild cards" by selecting them off of a convenient "Quick List".

Optionally saves the last X searches.

Lets you save your search results between launches. This saves you time when examining many "hits" by not forcing you to re-execute your search time after time.

Lets you find text even if it is not at the beginning of the word.

Unlike other search by content applications you may have used, IntelligentFind does not require you to create an index file before performing a search.

Displays results ranked by relevancy.

Displays results grouped by application.

Lets you sort results by relevancy OR application found in.

Lets you show/hide the relevancy ranking number.

Lets you show/hide the application the "hit" was found in.

Lets you reverse the sort order in the "hit" list.

Lets you reverse the sort order in the "hit" list.

"plug-in" architecture.

Allows you to selectively search one or more applications.

Lets you pre-configure up to 1000 permanent searches with their search rules.
